

WHAT TO DO DURING AN AUTO ACCIDENT:

STEP 01

CHECK FOR INJURIES:

First, check yourself and others involved in the accident for any injuries and call for medical help if needed.

STEP 02

MOVE TO SAFETY:

If possible, move your vehicle to a safe location to avoid further accidents or hazards.

STEP 03

CALL THE POLICE:

Contact the police to report the accident and wait for them to arrive to file an official report. Call the police to file a report even if the accident was minor or the other party does not want you to call.

STEP 04

EXCHANGE INFORMATION:

Exchange contact and insurance details with the other parties involved in the accident.

STEP 05

GATHER INFORMATION:

Take photos of the accident scene, vehicle damages, and any relevant details that might be useful for insurance purposes.

STEP 06

CONTACT YOUR SUPERVISOR:

Inform your supervisor about the accident as soon as possible so we can begin to file an insurance claim.

STEP 07

SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION:

Even if you don't feel seriously injured, it's a good idea to get checked by a healthcare professional to rule out any hidden injuries.

STEP 08

COOPERATE WITH AUTHORITIES:

Be cooperative with the police and follow their instructions during the investigation.



Remember, it's crucial to stay calm and not admit fault at the scene of the accident. Leave the determination of fault to the insurance companies and the authorities. At the same time be sympathetic and understanding. Accidents do happen and getting hostile towards the other party will just make the situation worse.
